

# **AL FAROOK RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL, FAROOK COLLEGE**

## **ANNUAL REPORT-2018-19**

The school re-opened after summer vacation on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2018 with 1393 students and 60 teaching staff and 16 non-teaching staff for the academic year 2018-19.

Here are the glimpses of academic and non-academic activities of the school.

### **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS**

#### **AISSE & AISSCE 2018**

Al Farook Residential School maintained 100% result in All India Secondary School Examination 2018 (Class X Board Examination). Total 105 students appeared in the examination. 10 students secured 90 and above in all subjects. 28 students secured 90 and above in all subjects aggregate, 88 students were placed with distinction and 17 students secured first class. Rahul Krishna became topper with 97% marks in AISSE 2018.

In All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination, 31 students appeared and 29 students passed. 6 students scored more than 90 % marks in Class XII examination. 19 students achieved Distinction and 10 students bagged First class. Samreen was the top scorer in class XII with 95% marks in AISSCE-2019.

#### **AISSE & AISSCE 2019**

The school bagged 100 % pass in AISSE (CBSE Class X board Examination) 2019. Among the 98 students who appeared for the examination, 21 students secured A1 grade (Marks 91- 100) in all subjects. 49 students scored above 90 marks in all subjects aggregate. 87 students bagged distinction and 11 students got first class. Aysha Aleena of Class X scored 100 marks in Mathematics. 9 students bagged 100 marks in IT subject. Archana and Akash V Satheesh became the toppers in the exam with 98 % marks.

School got 100% pass in All India Secondary School Certificate Examination (CBSE Class XII). Out of the 13 students who appeared for the examination, 2 students obtained above 90%. 4 students got distinction. As 7 students scored first class mark, 2 students scored second class mark. Salma of Class XII was the school top scorer with 94% mark.

## **RECOGNITION & AWARDS**

The school received PM Foundation's **Justice Khalid Memorial Institutional Excellence Award** 6<sup>th</sup> time in a row for the outstanding performance in CBSE class X examination.

The school bagged **Best Performance Award for achieving 2 ranks in Super Scholar Science Talent Test 2018 conducted by inspire learning**. Archana and Akash of Class X won 1<sup>st</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> rank respectively.

Students of Al Farook Residential School secured 5 ranks in district level in **VVM National Talent Search Examination conducted by the Department of Science and Technology and NCERT under the Government of India**. Adithya Raj (Grade VI), Ishan Gafoor (Grade VII) and Zuha Muneer P T (Grade IX) won 2<sup>nd</sup> rank and Fijna Firos (Grade VII) and Muhammed Shuhaib (Grade: IX) bagged 3<sup>rd</sup> rank.

## **QUALITY ENHANCEMENT ACTIVITIES**

Special coaching was provided to the students in difficult subjects. We also organized Mathematics foundation class entitled 'INTEGRATOR' for the students of classes III to X and Hindi foundation class namely LAKSHYA for the students of the classes V to VIII. The school also organized study camp in the evening and night for X and XII students.

## **SCIENCE EXHIBITION**

The science Club of School organized Science exhibition on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2019 in which our students exhibited their scientific skills through their working and still models.

## **CBSE REGIONAL LEVEL SCIENCE EXHIBITION-2019**

The school participated in the CBSE regional level Science exhibition organized at Palghat Lions School, Palakkad on 21 & 22 January 2019. Our students presented an investigatory project on 'the ways to improve efficiency of LPG in our kitchen' and a working model on 'Solar Energy in Automobiles'. The participants received special appreciation from the judges.

## **DISTRICT LEVEL MATHS QUIZ COMPETITION-'INFINITUM-18'**

Al Farook Residential School was the venue for district level Math's Quiz Competition '**Infinitem 18**' which was held by **Club Mathematica** of NIT, Calicut on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2019. Around 32 teams participated in this competition.

## **SCHOOL ANNUAL SPORTS MEET**

The school annual sports meet was held on 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.

## **RELIANCE STATE YOUTH ATHLETIC MEET**

The school athletic team participated in Reliance State Youth Athletic Meet held at Calicut University Stadium and won 3 gold medals, 3 silver medals and 8 bronze medals respectively.

## **10<sup>TH</sup> KOZHIKODE DISTRICT PROMOTION MINI ATHLETIC MEET**

The school athletic team also participated in 10<sup>th</sup> Kozhikode District Promotion Mini Athletic Meet and won 7 Silver medals and 5 Bronze Medals.

## **MALABAR SAHODAYA CBSE ATHLETIC MEET**

Our school participated in Malabar Sahodaya Athletic Meet and won **6<sup>th</sup> position** with 6 gold medals, 4 silver medals and 12 bronze medals. Arafa K. P became the individual Champion under 14 girls.

Sahodaya Inter School Badminton Tournament was held at Frook College Indoor stadium on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

Our school football team participated in the Sahodaya Inter School Football Tournament. Nihal Ali (X) selected as the best Goal Keeper.

## **KOZHIKODE DISTRICT JUNIOR KHO- KHO CHAMPIONSHIP**

The school team participated in the Kho-Kho championship and won 3<sup>rd</sup> position. Ridha Ilyas of Class X got selection to State Kho –Kho team.

## **INTERNATIONAL BEACH COMBAT GAME 2019**

Abdul Hadi PB of Class VII participated in International Beach Combat Games held in Goa on 16,17,18,19 and 20 January 2019 and won gold medal for India.

## **ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR TEACHERS**

The school Organized 3 days in- house training programme for teachers on 21, 22 and 23 May 2018. Teachers also attended in the training programmes conducted by CBSE's Centre of Excellence, Kochi. CBSE Capacity Building Programme on 'Inclusive education' was conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at Al Farook Residential school. Principals, Vice Principals and teachers from 35 schools participated in the programme.

## **MOTIVATION CLASS FOR STUDENTS&EFFECTIVE PARENTING SESSIONS FOR PARENTS**

The school arranged motivation classes for the students of higher classes. Apart from that school organized effective parenting classes.

## **‘EXITO’, A COMPLETE TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR STUDENTS**

To identify the potential of the children and to equip them for the future world, school started a complete training programme for students entitled Exito. It focused on Personality development, skill development, career guidance, training for competitive examinations and guidance to get various scholarships etc.

## **SPORTS COACHING CAMP**

The school arranged evening and holiday coaching camps for students in Football, Taekwondo, Badminton, Volleyball, Cricket, Khokho and Chess.

## **ANNUAL DAY CELEBRATION AND VALEDICTORY FUNCTION OF SILVER JUBILEE CELEBRATION**

The Annual Day and the Valedictory function of silver jubilee celebrations were held on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019. Honourable Member of the Parliament Shri. E.T Muhammed Basheer inaugurated the function. Kerala CBSE School Management Association President, Adv. Ibrahim khan delivered the key note address. The school Silver Jubilee Souvenir ‘Reminisce’ was also released on this occasion. The social Day was celebrated on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

## **CHARITABLE ACTIVITY**

The Management and PTA together donated 250000/- (Management share 50,000 and PTA share Rs.200000/-)to CM's flood relief fund. PTA donated 25000/- rupees to a family of Paruthipara which was affected by flood. Students and teachers donated Rs.95000/- for the liver transplantation surgery of a parent of Class XI. Student Arts club of our school organized a painting Exhibition at Kerala Lalithakala Academy Art Gallery, Kozhikode to raise fund to help the victims of flood. Kozhikode district assistant collector, Anju IAS inaugurated the exhibition. A painting competition was also organized by school Arts club for raising the fund. They collected a sum of Rs.35000/-.Students also donated food, clothes, notebooks etc. to the victims of flood.

## **STUDY TOUR**

The school organized study tours for the students to build closer bonds with their classmates and teachers, experience new environment, explore the new realm of knowledge and enjoy away from classroom.
