Now this Deed of Trust witnesses as follows:

- 1. Name of the Trust The name of the Trust shall be Fr Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School. Lugandiyur.
- 2. Status of the Trust Fr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School, Engandiyur belongs to the Christian minority community.

3. Registered Office

The Registered office of the Tour stall be at Tr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School. Engadiyate are Kerala State. PIN 680615. The Registered office of the Trust are be shifted to any other place in India as may be decided by the Beast Trustees of the Tr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School. - Area of Operation
 The area of operation of the Trust shall be within the territory of India.
- Objects of the Trust
 The objects for which the trust is established are as follows:
 - a) To provide education and training to the members of the society, without discrimination of easte or creed, adequate to meeting the challenges of modern society by establishing and running educational institutions of all categories such as schools, colleges, professional and technical institutions including Medical, Dental and Nursing Colleges, M.B.A/B.Ed, colleges and Engineering Colleges;
 - b) To render health care services, including establishment and running o hospitals, dispensaries, mobile health care units and conducting awareness programmes on health care.
 - To devise and implement schemes for alleviating poverty, especially of the rural poor, through awareness generation, self-help schemes, employment generation, etc;
 - d) To start, establish and equip educational or charitable institutions for the diffusion of useful knowledge, cultural, scientific, technical or social, and to apply for and obtain for them, wherever necessary either recognition form the government or university, educational or office authorities as the case may be;
 - To establish homes for the aged and destitute, especially for women, irrespective of caste, creed or community
 - To establish day care centres for the aged;

- k) To establish and maintain institutions for study and research in emerging fields of science and technology;
- To establish, organize, assist, subsidise and/or take over educational and training institutions for the benefit of the public and students in particular.
- To offer full-time, part-time and short term programs to upgrade the technical skills of the young and talented;
- To establish and manage professional institutions, boarding houses, hostels, libraries, etc. for the purpose of spreading education;
- o) To organize, provide and maintain facilities for holding lectures, seminars, classes, studies, courses of work, examination and tests and conferment of Degree, Diploma and certificates for professional studies, training or other attainment and holding of competitions in connection with professional subjects;
- Fo arranging for, and give, awards and prices, and to provide, establish, institute, administer, conduct and undertake grants, scholarships, research fellowships and other benefactions;
- To print, publish and distribute reports, journals, periodicals and other relevant literature intended to promote the objectives of the Trust;
- To promote entreprencurial skills among the youth;

- s) To exist the placement of observed unemployed,
- To collaborate with materials, institutions or organizations within India or abroad for the furtherwise of any or all of the objectives of the Trust;
- To develop, extend, support or after and equip all the works and activities of the Trust in the amanner as Board of Trustees may deem fit,
- v) To function as a non-political and non-profit making organization,
- w) To do all such other lessful acts, deeds and things as the Trust may consider incidental or confucive to the attainment of any of the objective of the Trust.

Ways and Means

In order to attain the above said arms and objects, the Trust shall be at liberty to accept contributions and donations, whether in each or in kind by way of any movable and/or immovable properties;

Board of Trustees

The Trustees shall collectively be called the Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as the Board. The overall administration, management and control of the Trust shall vest in the Board. The Board shall function as per the provisions of the statutes, rules and regulations of the Catholic Archdiocese of Trichur. The vicar of the St. Thomas Church. Ex-officio member, shall be the Chairman of the Board. The Board shall elect from among themselves a Secretary and a Treasurer. The following are the members of the present Board:

The tenure of all nominated members on the Board shall be three years. They are, however, eligible for re-nomination.

8. Powers and duties of the Board

The Board shall have the following powers and duties:

- a) To organize, administer and control the activities and programmes of the Trust trust properties, the institutions established by, and belonging to, the Trust or under its management.
- b) To chalk out ways and means to raise funds by donation or otherwise for financing the programmes in fulfillment of objectives of the Trust and executing them.
- c) Fo borrow any amount or to continue to avail of the amount already borrowed from individuals, banks, financial institutions or of her institutions or other institutions, with or without interest for any objects of the trust.
- d) To purchase or otherwise acquire for the Trust, any property, whether movable or immovable, at such price and on such terms and conditions, as the Board thinks fit. The Board shall have power to sell or otherwise Dispose of or mortgage any of the properties of the Trust at any price and such terms and conditions as the Board thinks fit, in the best interest of the Trust.
- To acquire by gift, purchase, hire, exchange, lease or otherwise, suitable land, vacant or with buildings, and to build or acquire buildings, furniture, equipments, vehicles, etc;
- To sanction funds for meeting the expenses of the Trust and its activities and also to grant scholarships and to provide funds for the poor students.
- g) To appoint or employ such staff as may be necessary for efficient management of the institutions owned and run by the Trust, and to prescribe duties of, and to take, where necessary, disciplinary action against, any of the employees of the Trust. The appointment of the staff should get approval in a meeting in which the ex-officio chairman is present.

- To institute, conduct defend, compound and abandon any legal proceedings by or against the Trust.
- To appoint auditors for scentiny of accounts and to make reports thereon.
- j) The Board shall have the power to rent out lease out the properties of the Trust and also to take on tent, lease or hire purchase, any items required for the satisfactory fulfillment of the object of the I rust on such terms and conditions as decided by it.

Meeting of Board

- The Board shall meet as often as required, but shall meet at least once in two months;
- b) There shall be at least 5 days notice for meeting of the Board;
- c) The quorum for the meeting shall be two-third of the strength of the board;
- d) All decisions of the Board shall be taken by majority votes and all major decisions and policy matters shall be subject to the approval of the Archeparchial Curia of the Catholic Archdiocese of Trichur.

10.Patron

The Archbishop of the Catholic Archdiocese of Trichur shall be the Patron of the Trust. The Patron shall have the power at any time to appoint, re-appoint or remove the members of the Board.

11.Chairman

The Chairman of the Board shall be the overall in-charge of the Trust. The activities of the Trust shall be conducted by him under the general supervision and guidance of the Board. He shall also preside over the meetings of the Board.

12.Secretary

The responsibilities of the secretary shall include convening the meetings, preparing minutes, assisting the Board in its correspondence, liaising with the Government and other agencies.

13. Treasurer

The responsibilities of the Treasurer shall include the following:

- maintaining the accounts of income and expenditure of the Fr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School, Engandiyar;
- b) preparing monthly/yearly accounts and furnish them with the approval of the Board to the Archdiseese of Trichur;
- producing the accounts and related documents of the Fr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School, Engandiyur;
- maintaining all records related to financial and property matters of the Fr.Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School, Engandiyur;

14. Trust Fund

The Trust Fund is Rs.10000F(Rupees Ten thousand only) which the settler has made over to the Trustees to hold the same together with all additions and accretions thereto and all properties that may be acquired by purchase, lease, gift, donation or otherwise and shall be the subject matter of the Trust (hereinafter called the Trust Fund) for the objects and on the terms and conditions contained herein.

15. Income derived out of Trust Fund:

The income of the Trust shall be used solely for the promotion of the aims and objects of the Trust and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to the Trustees. However, all expenses incurred by the Trustees to discharge their duties as Trustees shall be met from the Trust Fund.

16. Investments:

Investments of the Trust Fund shall be made only in accordance with the provisions contained in section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

17. Bank Accounts:

The Trust shall maintain has a small(s) approved by the Board and shall be operated jointly by person as authorized by the Board.

18. Financial Year

The financial year of the Trust shall be 1st April to March 31st of the Succeeding year.

19. Annual Meetings of the Board

A meeting of the Board, called the Annual Meeting, shall be held not later than the 30th day of June every year. The Treasurer of the Fr. Paul Chittilappilly Memorial Public School, Engandiyur is responsible for getting the audit report and financial statements of the Trust sufficiently early and to place such reports before the Annual Meeting of the Board

20. Saving Clause

It is expressly declared that this is a charitable Trust and that no part of the Trust Fund or its income shall be applied for any purpose other than charitable in nature.

21. Indemnity

Every constituent of the Board shall be indemnified out of the funds of the trust against all expenses and losses incurred by them in the discharge of their duties and also such loss or damage which has incurred not through their willful neglect or default

22. Amendments:

The Board shall have, in consistency with the aims and objectives of the Trust, as herein before set out, the power to add, amend, repeal or modify any of these rules, by a 2/3 majority, and with the approval of the

Archeparchial Curia of the Archdiocese of Trichur and also subject to the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, Thrissur.

24. Dissolution:

When the Board feels to wind up the Trust and the trust can better be achieved by some other manner, the proposal to the Patron for his decision, and action to be proposal to the Patron for his decision of the Patron to trust the assets remaining after satisfying the liabilities to trust shall be transferred to any Trust Charitable institution to the Catholic Archdiocese of Trichur or, in the absence to trust charitable institution, to the Government.
