PARTICULARS OF FEES

When admission is granted fees must be paid in full including the admission fee of ₹ .../- immediately. A fees schedule of the School is printed separately and furnished with this book. Fee must be paid on or before 10th of every month and a fine of ₹ 1.00 per day will be levied upto the 30th of the month. After this date, if the fees are not paid, the name of the student will be struck off the rolls and readmission had to be sought if the student wants to continue and if a vacancy exists. **FEES ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

WITHDRAWALS:

- 9 Students who wish to leave should do so at the end of the year if possible or at the end of the term.
- 10 Three months notice in writing must be given or else the fees for the following quarter will be charged. Such notice should be given in writing by the parent/ guardian and not by the student him self/ herself.
- 11 Transfer certificate will not be issued until the fees and Other dues are paid.
- 12 To obtain the Transfer certificate the parent must Submit a written application at least 10 days in advance.

RULES OF ATTENDENCE

- 1 Students must come to the school regularly, punctually and dressed in the prescribed uniform.
- 2 All students must attend the morning prayer and assembly and should be in their class rooms before the second bell is given.
- 3 No student shall be absent from the class without permission of the principal. In case where the absence is due to unavoidable reasons, an application for leave duly counter signed by the parent/guardian must be submitted to the principal on that day or the next day.

- 4 As regular attendance is important for successful work, a prior sanction of leave when required must be obtained. Prolonged absence for more than a week due to sickness must be supported by a proper Medical certificate. Prizes will be awarded for 100% attendance at the end of each year.
- 5 Failure to do assignments, irregular attendance, any misconduct on the part of the student shall entail him/ her to such disciplinary action as may be decided by the principal.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

Library is the treasure of knowledge, care it accordingly. Strict order and silence shall be observed in the library and reading room. Books issued are to be properly taken care of and returned on the due date.

- 1 All students of the school are members of the library.
- 2 A student can borrow only one book at a time.
- 3 A student may ordinarily have a copy of a book for a week, and may have it reissued for another week. No book that is in great demand shall be lent for more than four days at a stretch.
- 4 Books will be issued to students during the library periods mentioned in the time table and also before and after school hours. No books will be issued or received in the teaching hours.
- 5 Reference books will not be issued. Every member will be allowed to consult reference books during the school hours only.



- 6 The Librarian may recall a book at any time, even if the normal period of loan has not been expired.
- 7 If the date of issue / return of book happens to a holiday, both the issue /return of books shall stand postponed to the corresponding day of the following week.
- 8 If the book is not returned at the expiry of the period of loan, or after the librarian has called for it, even with in the period of loan, a fine of ₹ 5 / day will be charged. Fines shall be collected by the Librarian and the fact notified in the defaulter's card.
- 9 Until such a fine is collected from the defaulter, no book shall be issued to him / her.
- 10 Absence is not an excuse for the delay in returning the book after the expiry of loan.
- 11 In case a book is misused, wrong handed, damaged or lost, the person concerned will have to pay the full price of the book at the current market price.
- 12 All markings, underlining writings, or defacing of books by any means are strictly forbidden. Fines shall be levied for violating this rule.
- 13 Members carefully examine the book as soon as it is issued to them. Any mark (soil,damage etc) must be reported forthwith to the Librarian.
- 14 Students will not be allowed to enter library with his/her personal bags or books. One can carry notebooks, with the permission of the Librarian.
- 15 Members shall not, on any account, pass on books to non-members.



RULE OF DISCIPLINE

- 1 Students must observe silence and maintain order at all times. Running and shouting on the campus is not allowed. They should keep to the left when using staircases and corridors.
- 2 School uniform is to be worn daily. Cleanliness of person and cloths is expected from every student. Students coming to school with untidy dress, hair and nails will be refused to enter the classroom. Children should bring clean handkerchief daily to school.
- 3 Students should be simple and modest in their dress. Gold ornaments should not be worn.
- 4 Care should be taken to keep the campus clean and litter should be put in the receptacles provided.
- 5 If a student causes any damage to the school property, the cost of repairs will be charged from the student / parent concerned.
- 6 Any change in address of students should be informed to the school authorities.
- 7 Students must abide by the rules and regulations and or as amended from time to time.
- 8 The principal has the right to expel a student from the school on ground of indiscipline or for any breach of the aforesaid rules of discipline without further explanation.
- 9 Parents should attend the parent-teacher meeting whenever it is convened.
- 10 Parents are expected to check their children's diary daily and they are requested to encourage their children to take part in all curricular and extra curricular activities in the school.
- 11 Parents are requested to take all complaint direct to the authorities, not to the class teacher.
