In this acadmic year 62 students appeared for XII (SSCE) Board Exam. Two students got full Al 40 got distinction and 19 got First class. Ancetta Binoy and Aavani Sumesh secured Full Al. Krishna Sajeevan became the topper in Science and Aavani Sumesh became the topper in Commerce stream. 72 students appeared in X (SSE) Board Exam. 2 got full Al, 44 got distinction and 20 got first class. ## Orientation Programme for teachers and staff
