- Registration: Schools are requested to report at the registration counter by 8 am on Saturday, 16th August, 2025.
- Language: All items should be presented in English unless specified otherwise.
- Participation: A participant may take part in only one item.
- Participant's ID card must be produced on demand.
- Teams: Only one team per event is allowed from each school.
- Supervision: Students participating in all items must be accompanied by a teacher.
- Judging: The judges' decisions are final and binding.
- Clarifications: Participants can contact the teacher in charge of their items between 5pm and 7pm for any clarifications.
- Props: The use of fire and any dangerous props is discouraged.
- Green Room Keys: Ensure that the green room keys are handed over to our school volunteers before leaving the campus.
- Property: No harm should be caused to school property. Our campus is plastic-free; hence, the use of plastic items should be avoided.
- Content: Any items spreading anti-social thoughts will be disqualified.
- Vulgarity: Any form of vulgarity will lead to disqualification.
