POINTS TO BE NOTED

- ❖ The content of all the Two NCERT books is divided into four parts allotting 30% for Quarterly, 40% for Half Yearly, 30% for Pre-annual.

- ❖ Syllabus is cumulatively covered – First 30% of the entire syllabus for Quarterly, next 40 % of the syllabus for Half yearly, remaining 30% of the syllabus for Pre-annual and 100% for the Annual examination with no session wise mark division.
